Oklahoma Heart Hospital on Monday opened a clinic at 119 N Robinson Ave. to focus on the unique risks for heart disease of professionals in the downtown business community.

Interventional cardiologists Ronald Hope, Mohammad Ghani, Kevin Miller, Thomas Hennebry, Derek Norman and Naeem Tahirkheli will offer noninvasive technology that painlessly gives patients early warnings that heart disease is developing. Diagnostic testing will include ultrasound cardiac testing, cardiovascular imaging, echocardiogram, carotid duplex imaging, venous duplex Imaging, aortic duplex imaging, nuclear cardiac testing, rest nuclear ventriculogram, and myocardial perfusion imaging.

Business executives are particularly vulnerable to heart disease because of their lifestyle, said John Harvey, hospital chief executive and president.

“They typically are under a great deal of pressure to meet business quotas and deadlines and tend to neglect their diet and exercise at the same time,” he said. “Our goal in opening a downtown clinic is to put cardiovascular care close to the business community so they can know their risk of heart disease and do something about it.”

Oklahoma Heart Hospital Physicians includes 60 physicians in 50 clinics throughout Oklahoma including hospitals in north and south Oklahoma City.
