

Integris will build \$1.4 million cardiac cath lab in Miami

A \$1.4 million cardiac catheterization lab at Integris Baptist Regional Health Center in Miami, OK, is expected to be complete by January.

MIAMI — Integris Baptist Regional Health Center in Miami will break ground Thursday on a new \$1.4 million cardiac catheterization lab.

The 2,400-square-foot facility will be on the south side of the hospital near the emergency department. It is expected to be complete by January.

The lab will have state-of-the-art equipment for catheterization procedures to examine patients for blockages in the heart and coronary arteries, Integris officials said.

Funding includes \$200,000 from The Mary K. Chapman Foundation and \$500,000 in donations from community leaders.
